HISTORY of HENRIK IBSEN LODGE No. 393 SONS OF NORWAY

Instituted March 11, 1934

Henrik Ibsen was a major 19th-century Norwegian playwright

In 1934 Henrik Ibsen Lodge was destined to have it's beginning. At a meeting held in Peter Nilsen's home, a question by Christ Myrvold to start a Lodge under the banner of Sons of Norway was heartily accepted. The aims and objectives of Sons of Norway were explained to the group by District 3 President Louis Olsen and Zone Director George Rostad. After discussion, ques-



tions and answers it was agreed that, on March 11, 1934, this new Lodge would have its institutional meeting. When the day arrived District President Olsen served as temporary President with members from Norge - and Brooklyn Lodges filling the other Chairs. Henrik Ibsen #3-393 was officially launched with:



On May 28, 1934, Henrik Ibsen celebrated this occasion with an opening festival in Forester's Hall, Bay Shore. Seven lodges were represented on the occasion.

Henrik Ibsen Lodge, has over the years, participated in many community activities.




On September 13, 1936 a severe landslide followed by a 12 foot high wave across the Loen lake, in Sogn, Norway submerged Farms across the lake, where 78 people died. Henrik Ibsen Lodge donated money to both Loen as well as aid to the flood-stricken areas in the Midwest in 1938.

During the World War II years, Henrik Ibsen participated, along with many other Lodges, in providing morale-boosting services to our armed forces overseas.



Another service of recent years is the Christmas food basket distribution to needy families in the community.



Following the fire December 1989 at St. Marks Episcopal church in Islip, a replica of a Stave Church, the Lodge donated \$1000 as well as labor to the restoration of the church.

Other than founding members, it is often times difficult to single out and mention those who have served Henrik Ibsen Lodge and Sons of Norway.

It is of historical interest to note that June Morris is the first woman to serve as Lodge President, Zone 2 Director, Zone 2 International Lodge Delegate, and the only Zone 2 Director to be elected to two consecutive terms up to that time.

David Morris served as Operating Group (LOV, Ltd.) Treasurer from August 1980 until December 1982. During that same period June Morris served on the Marketing Committee as Editor of "LOV NOTES."



Rusty and Fran Anderson

Fran and Wilbur (Rusty) Anderson chaired the Ways and Means Committee for the 1984 Supreme Convention. Profits from that effort were used to found the Long Island Zone Scholarship Fund.

It is of historical interest to note that June Morris is the first woman to serve as Lodge President, Zone 2 Director, Zone 2 International Lodge Delegate, and the only Zone 2 Director to be elected to two consecutive terms up to that time.



The Long Island Zone Committee has also benefited from the participation of many Ibsen members. June and David Morris both have served as Zone Chairman as well as Ken Johnson and Asbjørn Lageraaen. Perhaps the most outstanding contribution was by Finn Carlstadt, who served as Treasurer for 25 years.


Ibsen members have provided outstanding support to Land of the Vikings since the acquisition of that property in 1978. We have been there in work parties, including the first one in November 1978, and as paying guests and financial contributors.

The Zone started a fund raiser to show their appreciation to St. Mark's Episcopal Church, Islip, New York for allowing the Zone Memorial Service to be held in the church. Henrik Ibsen lodge contributed and the Church was presented with a Viking ship custom made for the Church. The ship is shown mounted in the Church.



The Ladies Auxiliary, with strong support from Helen Amlie and Gerd Eide, was started with the idea of helping to promote a building fund.

John Amlie was a prime mover in organizing the original Long Island Zone Male Chorus. The members of Henrik Ibsen were the major participants in the original Male Chorus as well as the now defunct Mixed Chorus.



The "Ibsen Courier", one of the first Sons of Norway newsletters on Long Island, was first published during the Presidency of Erling Kjeka in 1982.


